<p>Content Area Science/Social Studies</p> <p>30 minutes</p>	<p>Science/Social Studies</p> <p>Sixth grade students will have instruction in Houghton Mifflin CA Science textbook and McDougal Littell <i>World History Ancient Civilizations</i>. Lessons will be designed around language objectives and differentiated for English Learners according to their proficiency level.</p>
<p>English Language Development (ELD)</p> <p>30 minutes</p>	<p>ELD</p> <p>English learners will be provided with instruction in English language acquisition and development. Lessons will be designed around language objectives and differentiated by proficiency levels of the students. All other students will work on practice and apply activities such as: Accelerated Reader, Accelerated Math, writing, science or social studies projects, and technology.</p>
<p>Intervention and Enrichment Instructional Block</p> <p>*45 minutes</p>	<p>Intervention and Enrichment Instructional Block</p> <p>Students in Enrichment and Intervention will be provided differentiated targeted learning/enrichment opportunities based on assessment data results and identified area of needs.</p>
<p>Physical Education</p> <p>100 minutes per week (3600 minutes per school-year)</p> <p>Minutes to be taken away from Language Arts Small Group time and Content Area Science and Social Studies time</p>
